ORDER NUNC PRO TUNC
ON THE CITY OF DALLAS'S PLEA TO THE JURISDICTION

The Court considered the Plea to the Jurisdiction of the City of Dallas and the Mayor and the City Council Members of the City of Dallas (the "City Council"). The Court, having considered the Plea, evidence, and the arguments of counsel, hereby ORDERS that the Plea is granted or denied as follows with respect to the counterclaims asserted by Hinga Mbogo, et al. against the City of Dallas:

[GRANTED] or [DENIED] to counterclaim for violation of Article I, section 16 of the Texas Constitution.

[GRANTED] or [DENIED] to counterclaim for violation of Article I, section 19 of the Texas Constitution.

[GRANTED] or [DENIED] to counterclaim for violation of Article I, section 17 of the Texas Constitution.

Further, the Court, having considered the Plea, evidence, and the arguments of counsel, hereby ORDERS that the Plea is granted or denied as follows with respect to the crossclaims asserted by Hinga Mbogo, et al. against the City Council:

[GRANTED] or [DENIED] to crossclaim for violation of Article I, section 16 of the Texas Constitution.

[GRANTED] or [DENIED] to crossclaim for violation of Article I, section 19 of the Texas Constitution.

[GRANTED] or [DENIED] to crossclaim for violation of Article I, section 17 of the Texas Constitution.

It is further ORDERED that for each claim for which the Plea has been granted herein, that such claim is dismissed with prejudice and that for each claim, if any, for which the Plea has been denied, those claims may proceed.
