****COVID-19 DISASTER ORDER OF SUSPENSION No. 2****

**RELATING TO THE SUSPENSION OF SECTIONS OF
ALASKA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE AND SECTIONS OF ALASKA STATUTES**

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020, a Public Health Disaster Emergency was declared under AS 26.23.020 in anticipation of the spread of the novel coronavirus known as COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, to prevent the spread of the disease caused by the coronavirus (COVID-19), the State of Alaska is issuing Order No. 2 based on its authority under the Public Health Disaster Emergency Declaration signed by Governor Mike Dunleavy on March 11, 2020 and extended by the Alaska Legislature until November 15, 2020;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mike Dunleavy, Governor of the State of Alaska, pursuant to the authority vested in me under AS 26.23.020, do hereby find that strict compliance with the statutes, regulations, and orders of state agencies as set forth in Appendix A to this Order, appended hereto and made a part hereof, would prevent, impede, or delay actions necessary to as required by those statutes, would potentially threaten public health and safety and also prevent, impede, or delay actions necessary to cope with the COVID-19 public health disaster emergency, and that the language of each provision specified on Attachment A be suspended until 11:59 p.m. on May 11, 2020.

The suspensions set forth in Appendix A have the power of law and shall supersede all conflicting laws during the duration of the suspension.

Appendix A shall be amended as needed to meet the spirit and intent of the Order. Additional statutes, regulations, and orders of state agencies may be identified that should be relaxed or otherwise suspended in order to prevent, impede, or delay actions necessary to cope with the COVID Public Health Disaster Emergency, will be added to this Order.
