Narrative

On 10/3/2022 I Sgt. Cheeks was traveling I 85 North about the 72 MM, within the law enforcement jurisdiction of the Spartanburg County Sheriffs Office, when I observed a silver Acura displaying SC Tag# After running the license plate through SC DMV it returned suspended for failure to pay property tax. I then initiated a traffic stop at the 77 MM where the vehicle pulled into the median. I began talking to the driver, whom provided me a SC ID identifying himself as Thomas Fields. Fields stated that he did not a valid driver's license but that his girlfriend, the registered owner would come get the vehicle.

While speaking with Fields, I could smell the odor of what I know through my law enforcement training and experience to be the odor of raw marijuana. While speaking to Fields, him and the front seat passenger both began lighting cigarettes. I returned to my vehicle and after checking both Fields for warrants, Devante Fields returned with an active bench warrant out of Spartanburg County. I then returned to the vehicle and asked Devante Fields to step out of the vehicle. I explained to Devante Fields that he was under arrest for an active bench warrant to which he complied (Bench Warrant # 20192370948516).

I then explained that I would be conducting a probable cause search of the vehicle and asked if there was any marijuana in the vehicle. Both subjects stated not that they knew of. As I was searching the front passenger area of the vehicle I observed a black Coach bookbag sitting at where would have been the feet of Devante Fields. Inside the book bag was approximately 8.5 gross grams of raw plant material consistent with the odor and appearance of what I know through my law enforcement training and experience to be marijuana. No other narcotics were recovered (Citation # 20222580143816).


The marijuana was recovered and submitted to property and evidence. Fields was transported to the command post and placed into custody of the jail staff.

On 10/03/2022, while working a task force operation on Interstate 85, I observed the listed above vehicle traveling southbound I-85 going 67 mph in a 60 mph zone. Deputy Ledbetter initiated a traffic stop by activating the blue lights on his patrol car signaling the bus to pull over.

I made contact with the driver (Dao Yung, **Constitution** and advised him the reason for the stop. The driver gathered his documents, and I requested him join me back at the front of my patrol car. At the front of the patrol vehicle, I engaged the driver of the bus in a casual conversation while taking enforcement action. M/D Wasserman showed up on the stop a short time later and ran K9 Hyko around the vehicle. It was later discovered that K9 Hyco established probable cause on the bus.

While still conducting business of the traffic stop, other Law Enforcement officers/deputies began to search the under carriage of the bus and checking passengers above. I was later advised of different amounts of marijuana located in the undercarriage of the bus as well as in one passengers gray bag. There were three subjects that claimed ownership o small amounts of marijuana. There was also a dark blue luggage bag containing eleven vacuum sealed bags of high quality hydro marijuana located under the bus. No passengers would claim the bag. We took possession of all marijuana seized off the bus. All subjects were issued Uniform Traffic Tickets for the small amounts of marijuana. Their court date and time was also explained to them, which was January 19th, 2023 at 1500 hours. The marijuana located inside the blue suit case was taken for destruction.

The driver of the bus was provided with his written warning (Warning # 211548-BC) for the violation and was given his documents back. All marijuana was taken to the Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office where it was turned over to deputies for processing.

Narrative

On 10-3-22 while on patrol I, PFC Swanger initiated a lawful traffic stop at exit 63 Northbound on Interstate 85 in reference to unlawful lane change. Upon making contact with the operator of the vehicle Marques Hinton, I observed the odor of Marijuana emitting from inside the vehicle. Mr. Hinton was also traveling with two other males, Tyri Rogers and Damani Walker.

All subjects inside of the vehicle were removed from the vehicle to conduct a probable cause search. The driver Mr. Hinton was asked along with all other subjects in the vehicle about the odor of Marijuana to which he stated that he did have in his possession a small amount of Marijuana. Mr. Rogers and Mr. Walker stated that they did have small amounts of Marijuana in their possession as well.

Mr. Hinton was traveling with a loaded 9mm Remington pistol stuffed between the driver's seat and center console. When asked about weapons in the vehicle all subjects stated that there were no weapons in the vehicle.

Mr. Rogers was traveling with a loaded 9mm Canik pistol in the floorboard as well which is also unlawful. Mr. Rogers also had in his possession a small baggy with multicolored pills located inside to which he stated were Ecstasy pills.

Mr. Hinton was placed under arrest and transported to the Spartanburg County Detention Center where he was placed into booing for Unlawful Carry of a Firearm and Simple Possession of Marijuana. Mr. Hinton was issued a Public Contact (008857-AT) for the improper lane use.

Mr. Rogers was also placed under arrest without incident and transported to the Spartanburg County Detention Center where he was placed into booing for Unlawful Carry of a Firearm, Simple Possession of Marijuana, as well as Possession of Methamphetamine. The multicolored pills were field tested at the Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office and tested positive.

I will be seeking warrants for all charges listed for Mr. Hinton and Mr. Rogers.

Narrative

On Monday, October 3, 2022, at approximately 1241 hours, I Officer P Torrey with Welfford PD was on patrol within Spartanburg County, South Carolina, when I observed a white in color Hyundai Sonata sedan bearing South Carolina registration . While directly behind the sedan I observed the vehicle to have a defective passenger's side brake light, and also producing white light to the rear of the vehicle.

I subsequently initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle for the defective equipment violation. I approached the vehicle on the passenger side and informed the driver the reason for the traffic stop. I asked the driver, now identified as TASHA ZAYAS MCABEE, DOB: to accompany me inside my patrol vehicle while I conducted my enforcement action.

I asked MCABEE if there was anything illegal inside her vehicle and she stated there was not. I asked MCABEE if there was any marijuana inside the vehicle and she stated there may be some "pot" inside the center console of the vehicle. I asked MCABEE for verbal consent to search her vehicle and she gave verbal permission for me to search the vehicle.

Upon my second approach to the vehicle I detected the odor of marijuana, I know this odor to be marijuana through my training and experience as a police officer. A search of the vehicle revealed a clear plastic baggy containing a green leafy substance and had an approximate field weight of 8 grams. Three (3) T.H.C. vape cartridges were also located in the center console.

The evidence was collected and sent to the Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office for destruction. The driver was issued a warning ticket #202210032022 for the equipment violation.

There are no charges in this case. The green leafy substance was placed into Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office evidence to be sent for destruction.

My in-car video and Body Worn Camera (B. W.C.) were activated during this event.

Narrative

On 10/3/22, while on patrol within Spartanburg County, I merged on Interstate 85 NB at the 68 mile marker. I observed a white vehicle change lanes away from me into the far left lane. I observed that white vehicle cross the yellow line and ride on top of it, failing to maintain it's lane. I stopped the vehicle at the 71 mile marker in Interstate 85 NB.

Suspect vehicle is a white Chevy Malibu, bearing FL tag of

While approaching the vehicle I observed the driver making erratic movements towards the center console. When I got the vehicle the male had lite a cigarette (nervous response). The driver and only occupant of the vehicle was identified as Tyrek Moore. I noticed a strong odor of cologne (masking odor). When I asked for his rental agreement he stated it was on his phone. I asked him to bring his phone to the back of the vehicle so I could review the rental agreement. While Mr. Moore was taking his seat belt off, I observed his shirt pull up in the front and I observed a black handgun in the front of his pants. I pulled my weapon and held it at the low ready and told him to put his hands up. Mr. Moore complied with my request. Deputy Dolman came to driver side of the vehicle and escorted Mr. Moore from the vehicle, while also securing the firearm. I begun speaking with Mr. Moore about the handgun. He advised he had a concealed carry permit in his wallet that was in the vehicle. I got his phone and wallet from his vehicle. Mr. Moore did in fact have a GA concealed carry. I asked Mr. Moore where he was coming from and he was originally vague, saying leaving GA going to NC. I asked where at more specifically where and he stated Atlanta, GA (source location) and going to Greenville, NC. Mr. Moore was traveling on Interstate 85 which there would be more direct routes to his location. When asked about the length of the trip Mr. Moore stated, just a few days. While being vague about his trip, Mr. Moore would over explain other things. This made me suspicious he was deflecting from the reason of his trip.

Based on all of this information and the observed actions of Mr. Moore, I was suspicious Mr. Moore was involved in criminal activity. I asked Deputy Dolman to request consent to search the vehicle. Mr. Moore denied consent to search. Mr. Moore had a dog in the vehicle and I asked him to remove the dog from the car. Mr. Moore refused to remove the dog from the vehicle and demanded to call his lawyer. I let him to talk on the phone briefly and then requested him to hang up. He did not and I went to take his phone. Mr. Moore pulled away from me and I told him to stop. I grabbed Mr. Moore by both wrist as he tried to pull away from me. Mr. Moore fell to the ground trying to pull away from me. I then placed him in handcuff and picked him up off the ground.

I was concerned with running my own dog with the fear he could be aggressive towards Mr. Moore's dog so I called for another k9. Deputy Powell responded and conducted the free air sniff. Deputy Powell advised her dog alerted on the vehicle. A search of the vehicle was conducted and in the back seat a bag was located containing 10.2 grams of green plant material. Also in the back seat a larger black bag contained clothes and a clear bag that contained 72.5 grams of cocaine, 12.3 grams of crack and 155 blue round pills marked M30. The crack and cocaine was field tested on scene. All of the narcotics along with the gun was entered into evidence, with the drugs being in best bag S34470.

Mr. Moore was transported to the sheriff's office by a SLED agent and transferred custody over to jail staff.

I issued Mr. Moore warning 172519 for the traffic violation. Mr. Moore was also issued UTT 20222580093583 - Concealed weapon violation and 20222580093481 - Simple possession of marijuana. I presented this case to Judge Bagwell and he issued the following the warrants on Mr. Moore : 2022A4210205960 - Possesson of weapon during violent crime, 2022A4210205962 - Trafficking cocaine, 2022A4210205963 - Trafficking crack, and 2022A4210205964 trafficking schedule 2.

On 10-03-2022 I responded to Interstate 85 NB at the 71 mile marker in Spartanburg County as backup to Deputy Shields on a traffic stop.

Upon arrival K9 Deputy Powell had deployed her service dog and stated her K9 had alerted on the suspect vehicle. I assisted Deputy Shields with searching the vehicle. Once I opened the drivers door to the vehicle I immediately could smell the odor of marijuana inside the car. Also there was an overwhelmingly strong odor of cologne that had clearly recently been sprayed in the car which is very consistent with attempting to mask the odor of narcotics. In the center console I located a bottle of men's cologne. Behind the drivers seat I saw a small black bag. I unzipped it and inside I saw men's clothing. In the bottom of the bag beneath all the clothing I located a white grocery style bag. Inside the bag I located the following items:

- 3 clear plastic baggies containing a white powder substance that field tested positive for cocaine

- clear plastic baggy containing a off white rock substance that field tested for crack cocaine

- 2 clear plastic baggies containing a blue round pill with the impression M30

At that time Mr Moore was placed under arrest for Trafficking narcotics.

I contacted Animal Control Officer David Jorgensen who responded and recovered the K9 that Mr Moore had in the rental vehicle.

My BWC was active during this traffic stop.

SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT:

On 10/3/2022, I Deputy Dolman was riding as a two man unit with Deputy J. Shields (Primary). While on patrol, Deputy Shields initiated a traffic stop on a White Chevrolet Malibu for driving on the yellow line of the interstate. This is a violation of SC State Statute 56-5-1900. The vehicle pulled to the right shoulder of Interstate 85 N at the 70 MM. Deputy Shields approached the vehicle as I was back at the patrol vehicle. While at the window I observed Deputy Shields draw his issued pistol and began to give the driver/ sole occupant directions.

At this time I approached the drivers side and had the driver step out. The driver already had his hands on the roof of the vehicle. I told the driver that when he gets out he is to turn and put his hands on the roof of the vehicle. Once the driver was out I removed the pistol from the holster in his waistband. The driver was then frisked for weapons and the pistol was cleared. The pistol was checked VIA NCIC and came back clear. The pistol was a Springfield Armory Hell Cat 9mm. The serial number was

The driver was identified as Tyrek Moore from Union City, GA. Tyrek was still smoking a cigarettes' as he was removed from a vehicle. I could also see a small dog in the back. People involved in transporting drugs sometimes smoke cigarettes' when stopped by the police to mask the odor of any suspected drugs in the vehicle. It is also common for dogs to be in rentals during the transportation of drugs to make it more difficult for K9s when conducting a free air sniff of the vehicle.

I spoke with Deputy Shields who stated that he had reasonable suspicion to ask for consent to search the vehicle. I began to speak with Tyrek at the front of Deputy Shields vehicle. Tyrek stated that he was heading to Greenville, NC, which I know to be in the eastern part of the state. This is an odd way to take due to it being out of the way. After speaking briefly I asked Tyrek for consent to search the vehicle. Tyrek denied consent. I advised Deputy Shields of the refusal. I also completed a consent to search form and marked it as a refusal.

Deputy Shields began to speak with Tyrek about the consent to search and asked him to remove the dog from the vehicle. Tyrek began to be very argumentative and refused to remove the dog. Tyrek then stated he wanted to speak with his attorney. Although we do not have to allow this, Deputy Shields did. After a few minutes Tyrek would not relinquish his phone as it seemed he was stalling. While Deputy Shields was attempting to get the phone, Tyrek fell to the ground and at this point Deputy Shields was able to place Tyrek into handcuffs. I assisted Tyrek to his feet.

Cpl. Dean was called to the scene and so was a separate K9. Once both were on scene, a free air sniff was conducted and Deputy Powell advised that there was probable cause to search the vehicle. Once I was inside the vehicle I could smell an overwhelming odor of cologne mixed with an odor of marijuana. While I was assisting with the search I heard other Deputies state that they had found narcotics.

Tyrek was taken from the scene to the Rolling Thunder Command Post. I then drover the Chevrolet Malibu to the office so that it could be towed. Animal control was contacted for the dog that was found in the vehicle. The vehicle was towed by Bobby Edge tow service. I placed a broken Ipad into evidence for safe keeping along with a pair of Airpods and a GA CWP. EAN Holding was notified where the vehicle was towed to.

I did have my BWC active during this incident. I made no charges in this case.

I responded on the above date and time after receiving a phone call from Dep. Shields in regards to assisting him on his traffic stop. Upon my arrival Dep. Shields stated that the driver of the White in color Chevy Malibu, Tyrek Moore, had refused to consent to a search of his vehicle. Further, Dep. Shields stated that the behavior of Moore led him to believe that there could be illegal narcotics in the vehicle. Shields also advised me of a puppy sleeping on the rear floor board of the vehicle.

After retrieving PSD Baro from my patrol vehicle we approached the Chevy Malibu (FL Tag At the front of the vehicle I placed my 6 foot lead on PSD Baro's flat collar and gave him his narcotics search command. PSD Baro went immediately to the open driver's window and closed his mouth while inhaling through his nose while his tail began wagging quickly. PSD Baro jumped up and attempted to put his head inside the open window. After several seconds of PSD Baro sniffing around the driver's window and door seam, I continued him around the trunk and to the passenger side of the vehicle. At the passenger side, PSD Baro stopped again and attempted to get further into the open passenger window. After the counter clockwise pass of the vehicle, I reversed PSD Baro in a clockwise direction. PSD Baro again closed his mouth and sniffed around the door seam and open window of the driver's door. PSD Baro sat (trained final response) at the Driver's door.

I advised Dep. Shields of the indication and replaced PSD Baro in my patrol vehicle. During a search of the vehicle 72.5g of off white powder believed to be cocaine, 12.3g of off white rock like substance believed to be crack cocaine, 10.2 grams of GPM, and some pressed blue pills were located.

This concluded my involvement. My BWC was activated.

PSD Baro is a certified narcotics detection canine through the North American Police Work Dog Association.





Narrative

On October 4th 2022 I Officer Wright (Duncan Police Department) was patrolling inside the jurisdictional limits of the Spartanburg County Sheriffs Office on Interstate 85 South Bound Near the 77 Mile Marker. Officer Wright was in the number 1 lane and observed a black GMC SUV in front of my patrol vehicle. The black vehicle went all the way over to the number 3 lane. Mr. Emmett did not know the last name of either other person inside the vehicle, but stated that he knew them for about a year. Officer Wright asked if there was anything illegal inside the vehicle. Mr. Emmett stated that there was nothing illegal inside the vehicle. Officer Wright asked Mr. Emmett about specific drugs and when Officer Wright got to marijuana, Mr. Emmett's breathing changed, his heart rate appeared to increase and he stared at the vehicle. Officer Wright asked Mr. Emmett i0f he could search the vehicle. Mr. Emmett denied consent, but consented to Officer Wright searching his pockets. Sqt. Cheeks arrived on scene as backup. Officer Wright got the rear passenger out of the vehicle and he consented the Officer Wright searching his person. Officer Wright was speaking with the back seat passenger and approached the passenger side of the vehicle. Sqt. Cheeks was speaking with the front passenger (Identified as Marcus McKinley) and Officer Wright asked Mr. McKinley to step out of the vehicle. Mr. McKinley hesitated and then stepped out. Mr. McKinley consented to Sgt. Cheeks searching him and white Sgt. Cheeks was searching him, Mr. McKinley turned around and began to yell. Officer Wright observed Mr. McKinley shove Sqt. Cheeks and the two of them began to fight. Officer Wright turned back to the driver inside the vehicle and the back seat passenger and drew his service weapon. Officer Wright ordered the back seat passenger to the ground and handcuffed him. Officer Wright went over and assisted Sgt. Cheeks with apprehending Mr. McKinley. Officer Wright called for backup units and grabbed Mr. McKinley's left arm. Mr. McKinley continued to pull away from both Officer Wright and Sgt. Cheeks. Several Officers arrived on scene to assist. Officer Wright and Sgt. Cheeks were able to apprehend Mr. McKinley. Mr. McKinley was placed in the transport cage. Florence County K-9 ran the vehicle and advised Officer Wright that the K-9 alerted. Both pills bottle were recovered and taken to the sheriffs office to be processed. McKinley was also transported to the sheriffs office where he was transferred to the custody of detention facility

Narrative

On 10-4-22 while on patrol I, PFC Swanger initiated a lawful traffic stop on a silver in color bus on 85 Northbound just past exit 72 in reference to the bus making an improper lane change. I made contact with the operator of the bus who offered to open the doors to the storage compartment on the bottom. After the operator opened the door to the storage compartment, my partner Deputy Millen then used his Sheriff's Office K9 to conduct a free air sniff of the bus. During the free air sniff, K9 Harper alerted to the to the odor of narcotics inside the bus.

At this point all passengers were asked to exit the vehicle. Once all passengers were off of the bus Deputy Millen and K9 Harper conducted a search in the seating area to which he alerted to a black in color back containing approximately 153 grams of multicolored pills that are consistent with Ecstasy.

After the search was conducted on the top of the bus K9 Harper and Deputy Millen conducted a article search of the luggage. Prior to the search one of the passengers Stephon Lynhert McCartney stated that he had a large amount of Marijuana in a black bag on the ground that he pointed out to me. At this point he was placed into hand cuffs and placed in the back of my patrol vehicle. There was also a small amount of Marijuana found in his bag to which he claimed in the seating area of the bus.

I had the other suspect Dennis D. Maye step back onto the bus to be asked about the suspected Ecstasy pills found near his possession. Mr. Maye stated that the pills did actually belong to him. At this point he was placed under arrest and placed into the rear of Deputy Millen's vehicle.

A uniform traffic warning was issued to the operator of the bus (008868-AT) and released along with all other passengers on the bus. Mr. Dennis Maye was transported to the Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office and placed into booking for Trafficking Methamphetamine over 100 and I will be seeking warrants for him in reference to those charges. Mr. McCartney was transported to the Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office and placed into booking for Trafficking Marijuana and I will also be seeking warrants for his charges as well.

SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT:

On October 4th of 2022, I (Inv. Pennington) was informed by Deputy Swanger with the Gaffney County Sheriff's Office of illegal narcotics being located from suspects, Dennis Moye and Stephon McCartney from a traffic stop. These subjects were located on a bus from a traffic stop that occurred near the 7200 I-85 NB.

At the command post I was brought a black duffel bag containing 11 vacuum sealed bags containing GPM. I was informed by Deputy Swanger the GPM was located from Stephon McCartney. Dennis Moye was found with six bags of designer pills. Five of the six bags were grey designer pills. The sixth bag contained multi-colored designer pills. A small portion of a pill was field tested from one of these bags returning positive for amphetamines.

The GPM was weighed using an uncertified scale returning to approximately 10.1 lbs. The six bags of designer pills were weighed using an uncertified scale returning to approximately 153 grams.

The evidence was placed into BB#S34471 for further analysis.

Gaffney County will be seeking warrants.
